CONCEPT NOTE

1. INTRODUCTION:

Svends Project Chains (U) Ltd in partnership with prospective partners, well-wishers and members of the general community are interested in engaging in a Green Project in branded "Youth Center" in Katwe Kabatoro Town Council and thus be called "**Katwe Kabatoro Youth Center**".

The Goal:

The main goal of this Green Project is to provide a platform for meaningful youth mobilization and engagement in fishing villages:

Fishing Villages are largely vulnerable in a number of aspects that include; high level of illiteracy; Early child Marriages, drug abuse, crime, School drop-outs, disease, domestic violence, wildlife-human conflict among other silent challenges.

The project will create a means to enable successful profiling of these dangers; identify potential challenges, and design of customized mechanisms/interventions to enable young people participate in the drive to transition of their lives and community while giving justifiable consideration to the green ideology for sustainable co-existence between humans and nature.

We intend to kick-start the activities of this project with tree planting and a cycling event (Independence Day Cycling Race) which is scheduled for **09th October 2021** and has been annually organized since 2012.

2. BACKGROUND TO UNDERSTANDING THE KATWE KABATORO YOUTH CENTER GREEN PROJECT.

A Youth Center is a mobilization and engagement center that offers an opportunity to users of the facility and stakeholders to have a mutual relationship based on creating and building social – economic change in a society. 
