

THE PERSON OF TH

Background.

The National Union of Disabled Persons of Uganda [NUDIPU], is an Umbrella organization of all categories of Person with Disabilities in Uganda. NUDIPU came into existence in 1987 on November 14th.

The Mandate of NUDIPU is to advocate for the rights of Persons with Disabilities. The Members of NUDIPU include;

Uni-Organizations of Persons with Disabilities and District Unions of Persons with Disabilities. NUDIPU operates in all Districts of Uganda. However, today, 112 DUs are registered and 15 OPDs.

Vision

The Vision of NUDIPU is a just and fair society where Persons with Disabilities live a prosperous and dignified life.

Mission

The Mission of NUDIPU is to advocate for the Rights of Persons with Disabilities in a unified voice for improved livelihoods.

Having existed for 35 years, NUDIPU seeks to commemorate her 35 Years of existence. During the commemoration, the organization will take stock of her achievements and limitations. The event will provide an opportunity for showing case of the support rendered to NUDIPU in her day today operations by the government of Uganda, Development Partners and other well-wishers.

Aware that the government of Uganda joins the rest of the world to commemorate the international day for persons with disabilities, NUDIPU at 35 shall be used as one of the pre-activities to commemorate the international day for persons with disabilities. It is on this basis that a plan of action for government shall be tailored on the theme for the day of persons with disabilities.

Objectives

- i. To profile and popularize NUDIPU milestones, challenges and lessons learned @35 years.
- ii. To show case the talents of persons with disabilities.
- iii. To present a plan of action for disability inclusion by 2023. This plan of action shall relate to the theme for the commemoration of the international day for persons with disabilities.

To realize the above objectives, the following activities will be conducted;

1. Publicity:

- 1.1 Press conference. Press conference shall be held at NUDIPU on 10th November 2022. It shall comprise representatives from the national organizations of persons with disabilities, and journalists from media houses.
- 1.2 Social media spot message. One messages will be produced and promoted across the different social media platforms of NUDIPU as a way of popularizing the Event to the public.
- 1.3 Printing t-shirts. Branded t-shirts shall be printed to further publicize the event before, during and after.
- 1.4 Profiling NUDIPU Executive Directors and Chairpersons. There shall be short video recordings with former executive directors and Chairpersons of NUDIPU in regards to NUDIPU's existence and history.
- 1.5 Hanging banner. 2 hanging banners shall be designed and printed to promote the visibility of the event.
- 1.6 Develop and publish a newspaper Article. NUDIPU shall publish an article in one of the leading dailies with the most readership detailing the achievements, challenges throughout the years and a call of action.
- 1.7 Media Coverage. NUDIPU shall mobilize various media houses to cover the activity as it unfolds
- 1.8 MC. We shall identify a professional MC who will lead and guide us through the programme for the day through the event
- 1.9 Decorations. We intend to hire a professional to decorate the venue

2. Corporate Social Responsibility

As a way of creating publicity and giving back to community. NUDIPU shall through Corporate Social Responsibility identify a busy road where different persons with disabilities shall be painting. Besides, Bukoto Kisaasi Road shall also be painted as one of the advocacy interventions for government to help reduce the emerging disabilities.

3. Exhibitions

Various projects shall display information materials including fliers, brochures and video documentaries shall be shared to the public to demonstrate NUDIPU's disability inclusion efforts as a result of the donor support. Tables shall be organized at the conference venue for this purpose.

4. Legal Aid clinic

Persons with disabilities who are in conflict with the law struggle to access professional services of a lawyer to provide legal aid services to them. During NUDIPU commemoration @35, a legal aid clinic shall be set up at the commemoration venue and shall be manned by the NUDIPU legal team. These shall offer one on one legal advice, make appropriate referrals by sharing contacts of the various legal aid service providers.

Outcomes

- 1. Increased visibility of NUDIPU milestones
- 2. Enhanced disability inclusion efforts by government

Participants:

NUDIPU @35 shall comprise of the following participants;

- 1. OPDs; 16 Executive Directors and 16 chairpersons
- 2. DU; Over 40 District Unions where NUDIPU is operating shall be mobilized to participate in NUDIPU's commemoration
- 3. Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs). NUDIPU shall mobilize 15 focal point persons on disability from MDAs.
- 4. Members of parliament. 5 members of parliament representing persons with disabilities shall be mobilized to attend NUDIPU@35 commemoration.
- Development and Implementing partners; 20 Development and Implementing partners shall be mobilized to attend the commemoration.
- 6. NUDIPU BOD and staff; 20 BOD and 85 staff (64 full time staff, 7 hired drivers, 4 temporary staff, 6 volunteers) NUDIPU shall be part of the event
- 7. 4 NUDIPU former chairpersons and 3 former Executive Directors shall be coordinated to be part of the event
- 8. 6 University leaders of Students with disabilities
- 12 Representatives of persons with disabilities on boards and commissions shall be mobilized to participate
- 10. persons with disabilities role models. At least 15 successful persons with disabilities who have beaten odds in the various fields shall be mobilized to participate.

- 11. Disability inclusion champions. At least 6 persons or institutions who have demonstrated efforts in promoting disability inclusion shall be invited to attend the commemoration@35. These shall also be recognized and awarded by NUDIPU for their disability inclusion efforts
- 12. Corporate companies. At least 10 Corporate companies such as coca cola, MTN etc shall be mobilized to attend.

Resource mobilization

- NUDIPU activities shall be facilitated with project contributions and external fundraising drive.
- 2. T-shirts will be printed and sold to all members/participants including staff
- 3. NUDIPU will reach out to corporate companies to fundraise to fundraise for NUDIPU@35.
- 4. NUDIPU will write to the different donors requesting for support towards celebration of this day.




