The club has existed for three years. It holds its fellowship meetings at the Uganda Golf Club every Tuesday starting 6:30pm until 7:30pm.

We have embarked on carrying out activities that uplift the boy child. We have identified groups that we will be supporting through skills development, education, counselling for mindset change and economic empowerment for transformation and sustainability.

With little or no prior education, the **Hands-On-Skills development training** will focus on acquisition of "Building and Construction skills" which will enhance the youth to earn a living and uplift them to a better living as future citizens of this nation.

The Rotarians of Kyadondo through our BCUP Ambassador, we would love to support as many boy children as they could possibly come across, but we're constrained in terms of resources and it's for this reason we seek your support and partnership to render us a hand in uplifting the Boy child.

In the past year, the club has supported **Early Childhood Development** by raising more than **USD 10,000** to fund the development and renovation of an ECD center (Early Childhood Development Centre) at **Naigobya Primary School** in Luuka District.



We have also held reading camps to support literacy programmes by providing scholastic materials and programs in the **Katwe Slum** under the central district.

Extending service through environmental stewardship programmes, the Kyadondo Rotarians, have committed to supporting the conservation of natural resources with partners in communities at **Miti Conservatory company Ltd** found in **Mpatta subcounty, Mukono District**.

Other projects, supported before, include, provision of services in areas of maternal and child health to (RHU) Reproductive Health Uganda Kataago, by facilitating camps and equipping their clinic. For the on-going projects, under water and sanitation provisions, our choice of focus is with the law enforcement officers and cadres' operating and living in Kira Rd Police Station. This is still Work-In Progress.

This inspires fellow Rotarians and non-Rotarians to drive service through serving communities via developing impactful projects that bring hope and changes in our communities where we serve.

Through Networking, we pattern with several personnels and the institutions they represent with an end goal of securing several service opportunities that support us in growing and achieving our service targets. 

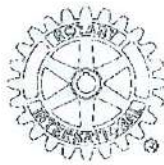

**PROPOSAL FOR THE BOY CHILD UPLIFTING PROGRAM (BCUP) - D9213 RY 2023/2024 BY THE ROTARY CLUB OF KYANDODO.**

**1. BACKGROUND.**

Back in the 1970s most families neglected the girl child; the boy child was given priority when it came to education, medical care and other facets of life. Movements, campaigns, literatures with the focus of empowering women and girl child made it possible and their situation improved.

However, the same struggles to put women and girls at the forefront have impacted negatively on the Boy Child. The exclusion of the Boy Child manifests itself in increased crime, low esteem, early sex, theft, early school dropouts, drug abuse and being a target for LGBTQ. As such there is need to refocus the attention to the Boy child while consolidating on the gains made in improvement of the wellbeing of the Girl Child.

In line with the Boy Child Uplifting Program (BCUP) - D9213 RY 2023/2024 initiated by the District Governor, Kyadondo Rotary Club has designed a project aimed at empowering the Boy Child in skills that include among others, masonry works, plastering, rendering, painting and decoration, tile laying, stone parking, welding etc.

**2. OVERAL GOAL**

To equip the Boy child with practical technical skills and ensure lifelong self-reliant and self-sustaining careers, which will result into uplifting their own families.

**3. TARGETED BENEFICIARIES/COMMUNITIES.**

The target beneficiaries mostly comprise of the youth between the ages 18 to 30 years from vulnerable communities such as slum areas, police communities, broken homes etc. Priority shall be given to the most vulnerable youth in those areas.

The selection criteria will be guided by the authorities in those areas e.g. (LCs, police, etc.) and the minimum target number shall be 30 but in total shall not exceed 50 beneficiaries.



#### 4. TRAINING APPROACH.

The approach will involve partnership with the following:

- a. Technical training centers such as Nakawa and Lugogo vocational institutions. These will help us in designing a short term training program at a more subsidized cost of training. The facilitators/trainers will be identified by these institutions and the priority is to train within the institution premises but in cases where there may be constraint of space, a training place shall be set up with the aid of partnering institutions;
- b. Established Construction firms who will be our funders and partners in further onsite training. The aim is that after the initial training, the beneficiaries will be sent/attached to the various sites, owned by these firms for further training and subsequent absorption in Employment. We have an understanding over this.

#### 5. FUNDING STRATEGY AND MANGEMENT.

The initial budget (Draft form) so far developed covering training materials, tuition fees and other logistical requirements is in the region of **UGX. 37,000,000=** as detailed hereunder:

The above required funds will be sourced from well-wishers including Rotarians and Constructions firms being direct beneficiaries of the trainees.

The campaign to get the required funds will be through writing to the targeted partners and the collected funds will be banked on a project account to be open by the RC Kyadondo for better fund management and accountability.

An independent on-site administrator will be appointed to manage the day-to-day affairs during the training sessions. His roles will include materials issuance and handling, trainees' facilitation, and any other operational issues.

In light of the above, a selected BCUP committee will carry out routine checks to ensure the beneficiaries optimally achieve and use the opportunity to change their lives.

## **6. SUSTAINABILITY STRATEGY.**

Training of trainers is our sustainability plan.

The Beneficiaries shall be trained in various skills and capacity building depending on their capabilities and interests. After the initial training, they will be handed over to our partners'/Construction firms for further onsite training and after gaining sufficient experience and these will be formally Employed.

For continuity of the project and depending on availability of resources, we shall identify the best trainees to become trainers of those that will not have benefitted in the first phase. With this approach, we will have more beneficiaries coming through.

## **7. EXPECTED CHALLENGES**

Mobilization of the required funds is a major challenge but it is also expected that depending on the locations of beneficiaries the issues of transport and feeding are likely to surface.

## **8. CONCLUSION REMARKS**

In conclusion, society needs to rise up from humanity decadence and ensure that Boy Child receives the same attention like it has been for the female child.

There's a lot to do for the boy child. It's important for parents and activists to also give time to the boy child.
