

AUDITORIUM FOR UNLOCKING THE POTENTIAL OF THE GIRL CHILD IN KIHURURA & KAZO DISTRICTS

Overview:

We are making history in Kiruhura and Kazo districts! With a combined population of 328,544, comprising 165,268 men and 163,278 women (*UBOS Census*, 2014), these districts have long faced challenges in addressing the specific needs of the girl child. Until recently, high rates of early girl marriages (21% in 2018), significant school dropouts (18.5%), and other concerning metrics signalled a crisis in the potential of the girl child in these areas.

Then Change Happened:

In 2018, the North Ankole Diocese pioneered a transformative initiative. By introducing the girls-only Bishops' Girls School (BGS) in Rushere, built on biblical principles of integrity and accountability, we have significantly reduced early marriages to 11.5%, decreased the cost of girl child education by half, and slashed school dropouts to 8.5%. Today, approximately 400 girls have been empowered to envisage a future that once seemed unattainable.

Our goal is to extend this opportunity to over 5000 girls within the next five years.

What is the Next Step?

Having laid this foundation, we've identified a critical need: a space for the girls to develop and showcase their talents beyond academic achievements. To address this, we plan to build a 1000-seat auditorium. This facility will be a hub for talent displays, school plays, musical performances, debates, lectures and many various co-curricular events - a vital component in nurturing well-rounded individuals.

PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF A MULTI-PURPOSE HALL AT BISHOPS' GIRLS SCHOOL, RUSHERE.

1. PROJECT BACKGROUND

1.1 Overview

Since its inception in 2018 by the North Ankole Diocese, Bishops' Girls School (BGS) has become a symbol of educational progress, offering comprehensive O and A-level programs in arts and sciences. As a fully-fledged boarding school guided by the Church's vision, BGS is dedicated to empowering the girl child for personal and national development. Serving Kiruhura, Kazo, and surrounding areas, the school has enrolled approximately 400 girls, significantly reducing early marriages and educational costs. Our mission is to further this empowerment by providing an optimal learning environment, including the proposed construction of a multi-purpose hall to accommodate the growing number of students and serve as a venue for extracurricular activities and community events.

1.2 Problem Statement

BGS faces a challenge with insufficient space to accommodate its expanding student population, now around 400. This lack of space limits learning opportunities, restricts entertainment options, and negatively impacts student performance. Addressing these issues promptly is crucial for enhancing the school's ability to deliver quality education and maintain effective operations.

1.3 Proposed Solution

To combat these challenges, BGS management plans to construct an eco-friendly multi-purpose hall, providing essential space for the school community.

2.7 Project Cost and Financing

Success will be measured by increased student enrollment, improved academic performance, talent development, and positive community impact.




ARTISTIC IMPRESSION OF THE PROPOSED MULTI-PURPOSE HALL AT BGS, RUSHERE.


