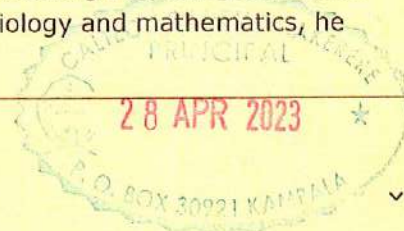

RE: END OF TERM I PARENTS' CIRCULAR

GREETINGS: On behalf of the entire Board of Governors, school administration, and staff, receive warm greetings and best regards from the Academy for the support you give the Academy towards the duty of educating the children of the nation.

ACADEMICS: The majority of our students who sat for UCE and UACE 2022 passed with overwhelming results. May God be praised and glorified. All the thanks and appreciation goes to our dedicated and hard-working staff and you our dear parents for your financial and moral support.

Our current learners were given mid-term exams and activities of integration for the new curriculum studies. We have had seminars for some subjects for our candidates. We had the end-of-term exams and every student is given a termly assessment report. All S.3 students have now fully identified their potential in practical skills. We have Baking, ICT maintenance, Rabbitry, Juice making, and Music. We registered those who paid the Directorate of Industrial Training – DIT fee.

PARENTS MEETINGS: We would like to thank the parents who endeavored to turn up on 12.03.2023 and 19.03.2023 for the S.4/S.6 and S.3/S.2 class meeting respectively. We encourage those parents that missed out, to endeavor to pass by the school to catch up with what was discussed. We pray that whatever transpired was perceived in good faith and would be for the betterment of the school.

EMIS registration was completed and all our learners were each given a Learner's Identification Number (LIN). We would like to request parents of learners in S.1 and S.5 to provide the school with their children's Learner Identification Numbers because they had registered in their former schools.

STUDENTS' DISCIPLINE: Discipline is a set of rules and regulations which are followed from childhood throughout our lives. A well-disciplined child performs their work in the right way and within a given period. So in cases of indiscipline on the side of our learners, the disciplinary committee has dealt with them accordingly, and some of them have improved. You are requested to continue taking part in shaping the behavior of every student.

SCHOOL FEES: We would like to thank parents who have struggled to clear school dues in time amidst the hard economic situation. We have been forced to discontinue the students who have perpetually failed to complete fees every term. All candidates are to report having cleared fees to avoid

distractions and the rest are expected to report to school with at least 60% fee payment and the balance to be cleared within one month.

NB: Next term's school fees is indicated on the Report Cards. Requirements (Ream, TP, Saloon) for next term will be 25,000/= for day scholars and 30,000/= for boarders

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES: We had an Easter Galore where students participated in different sports events according to their houses which included: cooking, bicycle riding, dancing, games and sports; tug of war (Pull the rope), poems, etc. Awards were given to the best students and Lobo house emerged the overall winner.

Table Tennis & Chess: Our Table Tennis team participated in the Secondary School Racquet and Bat Games Qualifiers and they qualified for the National level. The Chess students are going to participate in the 2023 edition of the Father Grimes Chess Championships. It is for this cause that the concerned students will remain at school to prepare accordingly for the tournaments which will take place from 06 to 09.05.2023.

Music Orchestra: We received a donation of Brass Band Instruments from the City of Strasbourg-France through KCCA. A group of about 25 students of our band will have to fly to France in the near future to join the international youth Orchestra; therefore, you are required to start processing their Passports for that cause. They will be having their holidays on the 06.05.2023 as they start preparing as well.
