GREETINGS: Best regards from the Board of Governors, School Administration, and Staff for the support you give the Academy towards the noble duty of educating the children of the nation.

ACADEMICS: We would like to thank God for enabling all our Candidates of the year 2024 pass with overwhelming results. All appreciation goes to our dedicated and hard-working Staff, and you our dear parents, for both the financial and moral support.

All learners were given Mid-Term exams and Activities of Integration plus End of Term exams which are all clearly shown in the Termly Assessment Report. You are advised to study it together with your child to give accountability of their performance. The S.5 class is staying for two more weeks since they reported late. They will get their Holidays on 08. 05. 2025.

The UNEB registration for this year's Candidates is about to be completed. We also encourage S.6 students to use this holiday to process their Birth Certificates since it is a requirement while filling the PUJAB forms.


• The on-going Boy's Dormitory Project that is purely a donation from the friends of the Brothers of Christian Instruction from Italy is now at this level. (The aerial view)



Second Term will Start on **25.05.2025**, and end on **15.08.2025**. The Visitation Day will be on **06.07.2025**.

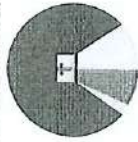
