**RE: REQUEST FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR EDUCATION**

I am writing to respectfully request financial assistance for my son, Kasirye Sekagya Isaac Gabriel, who has been admitted to the United World College (UWC) Costa Rica for a 2-year International Baccalaureate diploma program commencing in August 2025. He was awarded a 50% scholarship, which leaves a financial gap of US\$43,000 for our family. I am John David Kasirye, an employee of Buganda Land Board.

Isaac's admission to UWC Costa Rica followed a rigorous selection process organized by the UWC Uganda National Committee in December 2024 drawing eight hundred applicants. Fifty-eight shortlisted candidates, including Isaac, were invited for interviews held from January 25-26, 2025, in Kampala. He emerged successful and was nominated to UWC Costa Rica for a 50% partial scholarship. The official admission documents from the school were received via email on March 28, 2025, which prompted this formal request.

UWC represents a globally recognized network of 18 schools across the world. These institutions are renowned for their commitment to providing a transformative educational experience. Students are nominated through a merit-based application process facilitated by volunteer-run national committees in over 150 countries. The UWC education highlights:

- **Academic Excellence:** The IB diploma is globally respected and there is a strong record of UWC Ugandan graduates consistently securing U.S. college scholarships.
- **Intercultural Understanding:** UWC fosters deep relationships and understanding across diverse backgrounds, preparing students to be global citizens.
- **Experiential Learning:** UWC's curriculum emphasizes hands-on experiences, community service, and leadership development.

The value of a UWC education extends far beyond academic achievement. It equips young people with the skills, knowledge, and values necessary to address global challenges and contribute meaningfully to society. It is precisely because of the transformative impact UWC, that I am determined to ensure Isaac can attend. However, I am facing significant financial challenges, making it difficult to cover the remaining tuition fees. Therefore, I respectfully seek assistance from the Ruparelia Foundation.

### Agreement to Financial Terms

**Scholarship:** 50.00%

1. The cost of attendance at UWC Costa Rica for the two school years, 2025-2027, is \$86,000 (\$43,000 per year.).

Your scholarship is: **50%** you will pay **\$43,000** for the two academic years. **\$21,500** per year.

#### 2. Additional costs:

- \$500 Damages/Security Deposit (Refundable)
- \$500 min - \$1100 max - Immigration Fees (depending your country of origin)
- \$45 Bank Fee (per transaction)

#### 4. Payment schedule

- Families must pay a **non-refundable** deposit of 10% of the tuition fee + 100% of the extra costs (Immigration fees and security deposit) to reserve the space **within 15 days** of receiving this agreement.
- The second installment of 40% of the total tuition must be made **within 30 days** of receiving this agreement.
- The final payment of 50% must be paid before **June 25th, 2025**.
- Upload all payment proofs to your blackbaud account.

- (i) Copy of a valid photo ID (e.g. National ID / Passport bio page / Refugee ID / Student ID);
- (ii) Short essay "What does the future hold?" (350 words): Imagine it is 20 years from now, and you are being recognized for an outstanding contribution to society. What is the achievement, and what steps did you take to get there?
- (iii) Short essay "No pain, no gain" (300 words): Share a personal failure or setback you experienced. How did you respond to it, and what lessons did you take forward?
- (iv) Short essays "Time travel" (250 words): If you could relive a single day in your life to change or enhance its outcome, which day would it be, and why?
- (v) At least one (preferably 2) personal reference(s) from the school head teacher/principal, and/or a school teacher well acquainted with the student;
- (vi) Most recent official (school stamped) report cards:
  - a. If you completed S.4 or equivalent, provide S.3 Term3 report, S.4 Term1 & Term2 reports, and mock results;
  - b. If you completed S.3 or equivalent, provide S.3 Term1, Term2, and Term3 results.
